Available for iPhone and Android, Captain's Ledger supports personal recordkeeping; it does not determine credential eligibility or certify sea service.

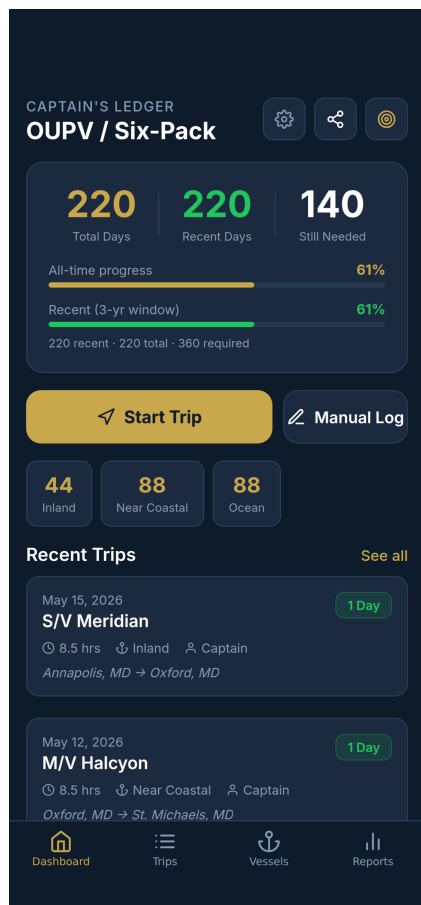

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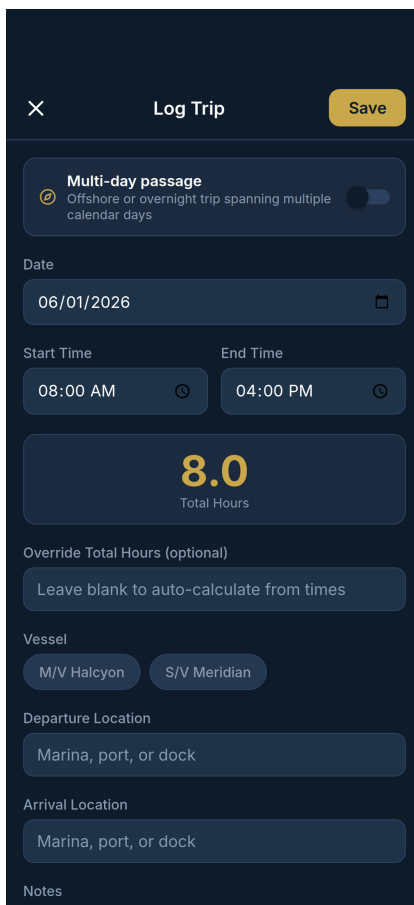

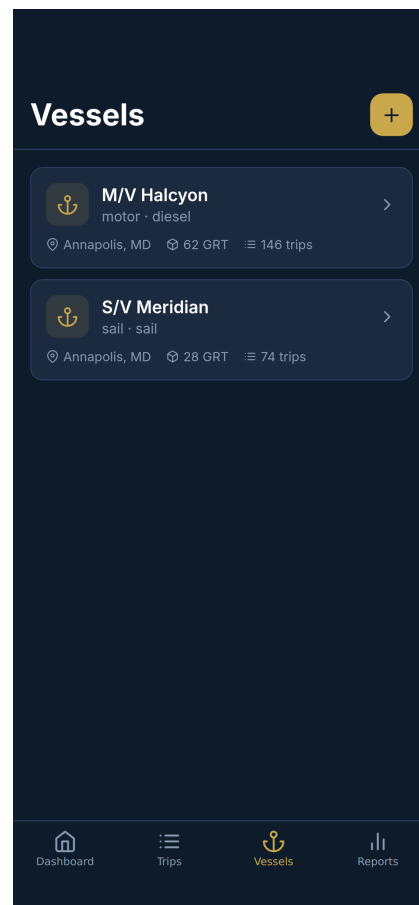
Sea-time dashboard
